Our subsequent destination is the idyllic village of Mounlay Idriss, nestled in the Rif Mountains and celebrated as one of the world's most enchanting villages, surrounded by captivating city walls.

The journey continues as we make our way to the vibrant city of Fez. In the late afternoon, we will gracefully arrive in Fez, ready to embark on the next chapter of our exploration.

Day 4: Fes City Tour

Continue your day with a drive to the illustrious Royal Palace or Dar Lmakhzan, followed by a well-deserved lunch break. Resume your exploration in the Mellah district, unraveling the district's unique charm. Visit the Batha Museum to delve into the cultural heritage of the region. Next on the itinerary is a visit to the Moulay Idriss mausoleum, offering a serene pause to reflect on the city's history and spirituality.

As the day draws to a close, return to your accommodation, cherishing the memories of a day filled with cultural discoveries and historical wonders in the heart of Fez.

Day 5: Fez ~ Cedar Forest ~ Merzouga (Dunes of Erg Chebbi)

Our journey culminates in Ouarzazate, often hailed as the "Hollywood of Africa." Here, amidst the vibrant energy of the city, you will spend the night at the Kasbah, absorbing the unique blend of tradition and modernity that defines this captivating destination.

By late afternoon, our journey culminates as we arrive in Marrakech, where you will be dropped off at your accommodation. Prepare to immerse yourself in the sensory delights and cultural richness that Marrakech has to offer.
