2 PEOPLE: 11 Day Luxury Antarctica Expedition

Day 1: Arrive Buenos Aires, Argentina

Arrive in Buenos Aires, Argentina's vibrant capital city. On arrival, please make your own way to your hotel, then enjoy the rest of the day at leisure.

Day 2: Buenos Aires ~ Ushuaia

This morning, check out of your hotel in Buenos Aires and transfer to the airport for your included charter flight to Ushuaia, the southernmost city in Argentina.

On arrival in Ushuaia, you will be met at the airport and transferred to the pier for embarkation. After boarding your boutique expedition ship, take some time to settle into your stateroom and familiarise yourself with the onboard facilities.

Set against the snow-capped Martial Range and the shores of the Beagle Channel, Ushuaia is often called the "End of the World". Its colourful streets, dramatic mountain backdrop and remote location create the perfect starting point for your Antarctic adventure.

Later today, your ship departs Ushuaia and begins its journey towards one of the most captivating wilderness regions on Earth.

Days 3-4: Days at sea

Spend the next two days at sea as your ship crosses the legendary Drake Passage towards Antarctica.

While at sea, take time to relax, settle into life onboard and watch the ever-changing ocean views from the ship's observation decks. These sea days are a wonderful opportunity to slow down, enjoy the journey and build anticipation for your arrival in the Antarctic Peninsula.

You may wish to meet fellow travellers, share stories over a meal or drink, or visit the onboard library, which features a collection of reference books about the polar regions, wildlife, history and exploration.

Throughout the crossing, the expedition team will host informative lectures and presentations, helping you learn more about Antarctica's landscapes, wildlife and fragile environment. You may also have the chance to join photography sessions and receive helpful tips for capturing the dramatic scenery and wildlife encounters ahead.

As you continue south, keep watch for seabirds, including albatross, soaring above the waves.

Days 5-8: Antarctic Peninsula

Over the next few days, discover the breathtaking landscapes of the Antarctic Peninsula, one of the most spectacular and accessible regions of the White Continent.

Surrounded by towering glaciers, majestic icebergs and snow-covered islands, this is where many travellers experience the Antarctica they have always imagined. Each day brings new opportunities to take in dramatic scenery, watch for wildlife and explore this remote polar wilderness.

Weather and ice conditions will guide your exact route, allowing the expedition team to make the most of each day. Possible highlights may include the photogenic Lemaire Channel, known for its steep mountain peaks, narrow waterways and mirror-like reflections.

Shore landings may also include sites such as Mikkelsen Harbour, where you may encounter gentoo penguins, snowy sheathbills, skuas and Antarctic Weddell seals resting along the shore.

Zodiac excursions offer another memorable way to experience the region, bringing you closer to icebergs, glaciers and wildlife while travelling through quiet, ice-filled waters.

OPTIONAL EXPERIENCE: Snowshoeing in Antarctica

For those looking for an even more immersive adventure, optional snowshoeing may be available during your time in Antarctica.

Led by expert guides, snowshoeing offers a unique way to explore pristine snowy landscapes and enjoy the stillness of the polar environment. This activity provides a different perspective of Antarctica's vast wilderness, with views of glaciers, icebergs and surrounding wildlife.

Please note that snowshoeing is weather dependent and subject to suitable snow and landing conditions.

Days 9-10: Day at sea

Spend the next two days at sea as your ship begins the journey back across the Drake Passage towards Ushuaia.

These sea days are a chance to relax after your time exploring the Antarctic Peninsula. Take in the sweeping ocean views from the ship's observation decks, watch for seabirds soaring above the waves, or simply sit back and reflect on the incredible landscapes and wildlife encounters you have experienced.

You may like to meet with fellow travellers, share stories from your Antarctic adventure, or spend time in the onboard library, which is stocked with reference books about the polar regions, wildlife, history and exploration.

The expedition team may also continue their onboard lecture program, offering further insight into Antarctica's environment, wildlife and history. You may also have the opportunity to join photography sessions and learn how to make the most of your images from this once-in-a-lifetime journey.

As you sail north, enjoy your final full days onboard and make the most of the ship's facilities before returning to Argentina.
